### Description

Height of the tree without its pot: 550 mm. Width of the branches: 630 mm.

Japanese pot from Nagoya: 310\*240\*115 mm.

Moyogi style.

Requires generous watering in summer and a regular fertilization all along the dormancy period in order to get a superb fructification.

Perfectly ramified bonsaï with formed trays.

Without any strong cutting wound nor wire mark.

Admire the superb sinuosity of the trunk, its mature bark and the harmonious position of the branches.

Variety with pink flowers in the beginning of summer and green canopy leaves.

Orange-toned leaves in autumn.

Particularly vigorous variety and perfectly adapted to the bonsaï cultivation.

Unlike the European species, it only loses few fruits until the end of Fall.

Vermilion red fruits of a size of a cherry.
