Description

Height of the only tree: 530 mm width of branches 440 mm. Traditional enameled pottery of 380*310*70mm. Style moyogi. This variety 'nejikan' has the trunk that rolls up itself on him even naturally. Ø 40-60 mm, formed superb nébari 120*140 mm , no strong wounds of sizes or traces of ligatures. The species cultivated in bonsaï will be placed inevitably in orangery (cold greenhouse) the winter not to undergo a frost racinaire that would destroy them irreparably.

The flowers, funnel-shaped, luminous orange red is grouped and blooms from July to September. They are followed of fruits to the tough skin of 6 to 12 cm of diameter. Thus, the pomegranate was supposed to heal the pains of teeth, because, trench, it looks like a mouth where the teeth would be the seeds. Bonsaï restructured in September 2015 by Me Nishikawa . Non included shelf. Topic exceptional has about 20 years of the nurseries Murakawa Kiyoshi, that formed it since a cutting. Picture november 2021 in autumn color
