Description

Table made of imported Samba rock from Japan.

Particularly decorative with its veined appearance and the elegance of its structure. Sold with its 4 stools.

Unique piece, naturally featuring a bluish-green veining resembling that of marble. Outer dimensions of the irregularly shaped tabletop.

Length: approximately 1700 mm.

Width: approximately 950 mm.

Thickness of the tabletop: approximately 250 mm.

Height from the top of the tabletop to the floor: 900 mm.

Stool height: approximately 500 mm.

Approximate seat width of the stools: one at 450*600 mm, one at 500*350 mm, one at 800*500 mm, and one at 900*450 mm.

Approximate weight: 900-1200 kilograms. This table is composed of three parts, making transportation easier – its two-piece, naturally raw-looking base revealing the veining, and its tabletop, the top of which is completely polished, along with the four stools.
